- Completed Grade 10; or
- GCE 'O' Level or its equivalent
- Min. 16 years old
- English Proficiency: IELTS 3.5 or its equivalent*

* To be exempt from the ESOL language foundation course, applicants **MUST** possess an English language proficiency level of IELTS 3.5 or its equivalent. **ALL** applicants **MUST** sit for and pass an English test conducted by the School. Otherwise, **ALL** other applicants are required to undergo a minimum of 10 weeks of the English language foundation course till the attainment of the equivalent of IELTS 3.5.

Industrial Attachment

Students who successfully complete and passed the course may opt for 6 months of Industrial Attachment, subject to the approval of a Training Work Permit by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM). Bristol Business School cannot guarantee the approval of the Training Work Permit.

Examination Period

June and December

Award of Qualification & Examination Requirements

Students will be awarded a diploma by City & Guilds if he/she achieves at least a Pass grade in the final examinations.
